Dear friends and supporters of WEYE,

Every April , we would like to give you a short review of what has transpired in WEYE from January to April. WEYE Clean energy is a green enterprise that is commercializing grass root waste to energy solutions as a tool to reduce deforestation while empowering youth and women in rural communities. Funded by our partners -Katosi Women's Development Trust (KWDT), we held two waste to wealth training workshops on These two-day training workshops were planned to train 20 women on proper sorting and storage of waste the first day and training 50 women on making of charcoal briquette from organic wastes on the second day.

Below are three steps we shall train them in;

1. Sorting the waste

The sorting process is the heart of recycling because any waste material can only be valuable if well kept. If organic wastes are mixed with inorganic waste, the rotten organic waste then makes the inorganic waste unusable.

2. Re-use of the organic waste.

The beneficiaries were to be trained in all processes involved in turning organic waste materials into charcoal briquettes that can be sold to earn income.

3. Recycling of inorganic waste

Selling of recycled plastics as a business.

Use of plastic bottles to construct mushroom houses.
